“NAME THAT BODY PART” EVENT GUIDELINES (14)

1. Each contestant must be a member of MLPNA and currently enrolled in good standing in a Mississippi LPN Program.
2. Each contestant will be given one answer sheet. Answers will be recorded on the answer sheet.
3. In the “Name That Body Part” Event, the contestant will be asked to identify, capitalize, punctuate and spell correctly 50 anatomical body parts. An additional 20 slides will be presented for identification and be used as tie-breakers.
4. Each correct answer will score 1 point. A perfect score will be 50 points.
5. The contestant with the highest score will be declared the winner.
6. Any answer which is incorrectly spelled, capitalized, or punctuated will be ruled an error, and 1 point will be deducted. No medical abbreviations will be accepted. All answers must be spelled out completely.
7. Each slide will be displayed for 30 seconds. The contestant must identify, capitalize, punctuate and correctly spell the answer on the provided answer sheet within this 30 second period of time in BLACK INK. Each answer must be PRINTED LEGIBLY.
8. Images will be displayed using Power Point.
9. In the case of a tie, the judges will use items 1-10 of the tiebreaker slide answers to determine the winner. If there is still a tie, then items 11-20 will be used. If a tie still exists, then the contestants will be asked to verbally and correctly identify the body part, spell it, name its location in the body, and state its function in the body. This process will continue until a winner is determined.
10. The decision of the head judge is final.
11. Each contestant is required to bring two black ink pens to the event room.
12. NO observers, faculty members, or other individuals NOT directly involved with the competitive event may be in the room during the competition.
13. Contestants may prepare for the contest by using any approved Structure and Function textbook for Practical Nursing.
